




Q4 - Did you serve as a teaching assistant (TA) or as a lecture-student assistant (LSA) for one or more for-credit courses in Fall 2020?




Q6 - Do you know the total percentage of your teaching appointment?




Q8 - What personal areas, if any, posed challenges for you during the Fall 2020 semester? (Please select all that apply)




Q9 - How did your stress level in the Fall 2020 semester compare to your stress level in the Fall 2019 semester? Your stress level in the Fall 2020 was:




Q10 - How did your workload in the Fall 2020 semester compare to your workload in the Fall 2019 semester? Your workload in the Fall 2020 semester was:




Q12 - Of the instructional areas you checked in the previous question, which area required the most time?




